THE PROBLEM

(James 1:8) A double minded man is **unstable** in all his ways.

(2 Pet 2:14) Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling **unstable souls**: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:

(2 Pet 3:16) As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and **unstable** wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.

(2 Th 2:2) That ye be not **soon shaken in mind**, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

(James 1:6) But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea **driven** with the wind and **tossed**.

(Eph 4:14) That we henceforth be no more children, **tossed to and fro, and carried about** with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;

GOD'S EXPECTATION

(Mat 11:16-17) But whereunto shall I liken this generation? It is **like unto children** sitting in the markets, and calling unto their fellows, And saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned unto you, and ye have not lamented.

(Eph 4:14) That we henceforth **be no more children**, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;

(1 Cor 13:11) When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but **when I became a man**, I put away **childish things**.

(Heb 5:12) For when for the time **ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again** which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

(Eph 4:15) But speaking the truth in love, may **grow up** into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

(1 Pet 2:2) As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, **that ye may grow** thereby:

(2 Pet 3:18) But **grow** in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.

THE EFFECT ON GOD

(Gen 6:6) And it **repented** the LORD **that he had made man** on the earth, and **it grieved him at his heart**.

(Eph 4:30) And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

(Heb 3:10, 17) Wherefore **I was grieved with that generation**, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways. . . . But with **whom was he grieved forty years?**

(Mark 16:14) Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and **upbraided them** with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

(John 14:8-9) Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us. Jesus saith unto him, **Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip?** he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

ALL HE'S DONE AND BEEN

(Ps 124:1-8)

(Josh 21:45) There **failed not ought of any good thing** which the LORD had spoken unto the house of Israel; all came to pass.

(1 Ki 8:56) Blessed be the LORD, that hath given rest unto his people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath **not failed one word** of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of Moses his servant.
