(Isa 43:10) Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he:

(Heb 11:6) for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

(Rev 4:11) Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

(1 Cor 2:7) But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden **wisdom**, which God **ordained before the world** unto our glory:

(Luke 18:42) And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: **thy faith hath saved thee.**

(Psa 78:41) Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel.
